# Family Intensive Program

## Experience God's Promise of Abundant Life.....in your Family!

Center for Relational Care uses an accelerated relational model of counseling for families in crises. In addition to focusing on behavior, we hope to identify and resolve underlying reasons for the behaviors. The goal is to develop awareness of root relational issues such as unmet needs and unhealed painful emotions and then experience relational healing in these areas.

At a family intensive, two CRC counselors work with a family over a two or three day period. Parents will also meet with a counselor to apply these concepts to their marriage as well as to their parent-child relationships. Family intensives typically involve older teens and adult children and their parents.



### The Experience

- Family Intensives are two to three-day therapeutic programs that offer structured, focused opportunities for personal growth and relational enrichment
- Family Intensives provide a safe, supportive, environment where God's processes for healing hurts, resolving conflicts, and alleviating fear are applied in the context of family relationships
- Intensives are often used of God to halt the deterioration of important family relationships before the pain becomes greater

### The Benefits

- Understand your God-given need for relationships
- Define the relational needs most important to you
- Learn how to meet the needs of others
- Develop skills for communicating heart -to-heart
- Experience healing of inevitable hurts in your life
- Gain freedom from painful emotions – anger, guilt, fear, etc.
- Replace unhealthy thinking and harmful behavior patterns
- Comfort hurts from childhood limiting your capacity to love
- Experience freedom to love God and others more joyfully
